BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE:

Through its Community Forest Agreement license tenure, the CLCCF has the authority and responsibility to conduct various forest management operational activities within its land base. This policy provides guidance regarding how these operational activities are to relate to environmental values.

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

It is the policy of the Cascade Lower Canyon Community Forest (CLCCF) to:

- 1) Comply with all relevant environmental legislation and regulations.
- 2) Strive for excellence in forest management by continually improving performance of resource management activities and practices.
- 3) Manage our community forest in a sustainable manner that is environmentally balanced, socially and culturally beneficial and economically viable.
- 4) Create and maintain a framework that sets and reviews environmental objectives and targets as well as promoting the prevention of pollution associated with the CLCCF forestry activities.
- 5) Ensure that all work by the CLCCF and its contractors adheres to any current CLCCF environmental management or forest certification systems.
